Why does it happen like that?

Highly recommended: "Expository Preaching", by David Strain

1. What do we preach? = The Bible

2 Timothy 3:16

→ inerrant, authoritative, sufficient, clear, Christ-centred

Q: Why must we be reminded of the need to preach the Bible?

2. Why preach the Bible? = In faithful preaching we hear Christ

Ephesians 2:17 – WHO came and preached in Ephesus?!

1 Peter 4:11, "if anyone speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God."

All through the Bible we see Scripture being preached

When we hear Christ's voice \rightarrow

- A direct encounter with the Lord: "preaching is worship and it evokes worship" (Strain)
- God's primary means of evangelism: "an effectual means of enlightening, convincing and humbling sinners... driving them out of themselves, and drawing them unto Christ ... " WLC Q155
- Principle means of discipleship

3. What kind of preaching? = Expository preaching

= The shape and the emphasis of a sermon should reflect the shape and the emphasis of the Bible passage in front of us.

The advantages of expository preaching?

- respects way God has ordered Bible.
- preserves the congregation from the hobby horses or personal obsessions of a preacher
- subjects our lives/needs/concerns to Scripture, for God's healing and perspective.
- teaches the congregation how to study Bible for themselves.
- does the "heavy lifting" of building up a church.

Important caveat: the Bible says we must do systematic theology / church confessions / catechisms / creeds

- 2 Timothy 1:13

Q: *There are many voices that compete for our attention. In what ways* does it reassure us to see how a sermon clearly arises from the text of Holy Scripture?

4. Getting the most out of expository preaching

Westminster Longer Catechism Q.160

- "It is required of those that hear the Word preached, that they attend upon it with diligence, preparation, and prayer;
 - examine what they hear by the Scriptures;
 - receive the truth with faith, love, meekness, & readiness of mind, as the Word of God;
 - meditate, and confer of it [i.e. talk about it with others]; hide it in their hearts,
 - and bring forth the fruit of it in their lives."

Q: How can we do each of these things? And help one another? And help the preacher?
