# **1. KEY FOUNDATIONS:**

# (a) Recap: He is sovereign over creation, providence and history (Ephesians 1:10)

# (b) We are totally depraved

Ephesians 2:1-3

John 8:44, "You are of your father the DEVIL, and your will is to do your father's desires."

Titus 3:3, "For we ourselves were once foolish, disobedient, led astray, SLAVES to various passions and pleasures, passing our days in malice and envy, hated by others and hating one another."

#### (c) God's chief end is His own glory

# 2. HE CHOSE US BEFORE THE WORLD BEGAN: ELECTION / PREDESTINATION

John 6:37-39

Ephesians 1:4, "... he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him"

Acts 13:48, "And when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord, and as many as were appointed to eternal life believed."

Questions...

"This divine choice is an expression of free and sovereign grace, for it is unconstrained and unconditional, not merited by anything in those who are its subjects. God owes sinners no mercy of any kind, only condemnation; so it is a wonder, and matter for endless praise, that he should choose to save any of us; and doubly so when his choice involved the giving of his own Son to suffer as sin-bearer for the elect (Romans 8:32)." (Concise Theology, p149).

### 3. HE BRINGS THE DEAD TO LIFE - REGENERATION

John 6:44, 65

Matthew 11:25-27, "At that time Jesus declared, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; <sup>26</sup> yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. <sup>27</sup> All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him."

Don't abuse God's sovereignty

Non-believer: repent and believe

Christian: humbled... and assured
