They are a bit

puzzled by what

Jesus has said and we might feel like that too. But we need to

understand

Jesus is talking about two different things that will happen:

1. The temple being destroyed.

2. Judgement at the end of

time.

Jesus tells his disciples what to expect:

- People pretending to be the

Messiah

- Wars
- Natural

disasters like

famines and earthquakes.

- Christians being treated really badly.

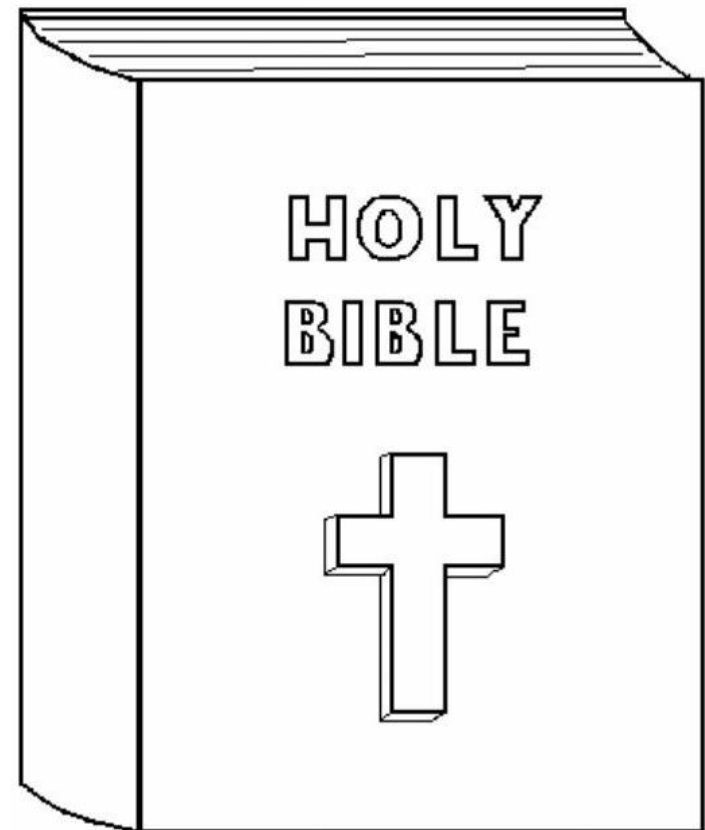
But also the good news about Jesus will be shared throughout the

world.

Then Jerusalem will be destroyed. Jesus told his disciples all this so they would keep

keep trusting

Jesus' words and not panic. This is a good thing for us to hear too, colour the picture of the bible to remind you to trust Jesus' words even when things are difficult.
