Listen carefully to the Bible reading from Malachi 2 verse 10 to 16

The people of Israel were getting things all wrong.

They didn't know what it meant to be God's people.


Let's see how Israel were getting this wrong.

Malachi brings this message to the people from God:

"You weep and groan because the Lord does not accept your offerings"

Look at verse 14. What do the people say?

The LORD



This was **not** an honest question. They were upset with God. They mean something like this:

"God is supposed to accept our offering and send us lots of blessings. Why does he not? He should be pleased with us!"

Wow! Can you believe it?

They still don't think they have done anything wrong! They think God has got it wrong!

Let's see what it really means to be God's people.

God makes a special promise to his people. It is called a Covenant and it looks like this:

The LORD


Israel

But the people were breaking God's covenant. Malachi tells them two things they were doing wrong.

1. Read verse 11 carefully. Who were the people marrying?

The people they married worshipped \_\_\_\_\_ (dlois) And they were turning the people away from God. What else were the people doing? Read verse 14. 2. They were not keeping their promises to their \_\_\_\_\_ (wvsie) When people get married, they make a promise to be faithful to one another. But the people were breaking their promises. They were leaving their wives and marrying others instead. God was not happy about this because he is always \_\_\_\_\_ (taifhulf) he always keeps his \_\_\_\_\_ (ioessrpm)

Can you see what the people were doing to God's covenant?



They thought: "As long as we make some sacrifices to God, we can do whatever we like"

But God still loves his people. This is why he sent Malachi to them - to call them back to him:

"Return to me, and I will return to you, says the LORD of hosts."
