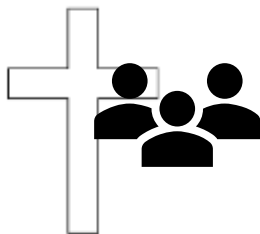
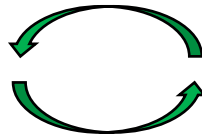
Can you see how this is like the Passover?

Wow! God is an **amazing rescuer!**

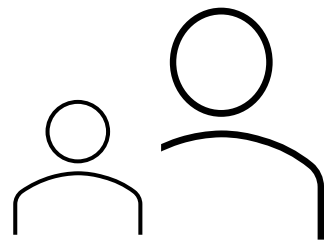
At the Passover the lamb died instead of the people.  
Like the Passover lamb, Jesus died instead of us.  
If we are one of God's children,

He is our **Substitute** - this means to **swap**  
Look at the pictures below. Can you see the swap?

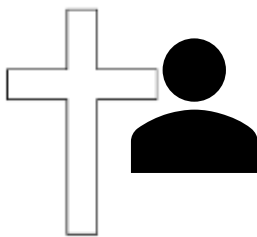
Draw arrows like this where there is a swap:



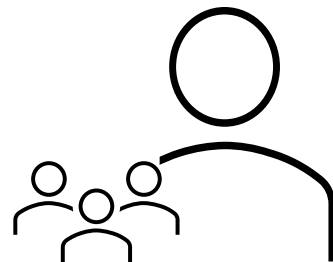
1. We have done

3. Our sin is put  
on Jesus - he died

4. So we can be  
God's treasured  
people!

We need **Jesus** and his body and his blood  
We need him to be our **substitute**!
