These things about God are called God's **Providence**

God's Providence means:

How God works to make all things happen for his own good reasons and his own good purposes

This is the **amazing** thing about God that we are going to be learning about over the next few weeks.

One verse in the Bible that says something about this is Ephesians 1v11. The last part of the verse says this about God:

"...him who works all things according to the counsel of his will"

Big things like the decisions of our Prime Minister


Personal things like when we play with our friends
