2. Our Father brings adversity

The mystery of providence

Isaiah 45:7, "I form light and create darkness; I make well-being and create calamity; I am the LORD, who does all these things."

Lamentations 3:38, "Is it not from the mouth of the Most High that good and bad come?"

Amos 3:6, "Is a trumpet blown in a city, and the people are not afraid?

Does disaster come to a city, unless the LORD has done it?"

Ecclesiastes 7:13, "Consider the work of God: who can make straight what he has made crooked?"

Christians share in the sufferings of Jesus

Philippians 3:10, "... that I may know [Christ] and the power of his resurrection, the fellowship of his sufferings, becoming like him in his death..."

1 Peter 4:13, "But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed."

Our Father disciplines his children.
