something to really thank

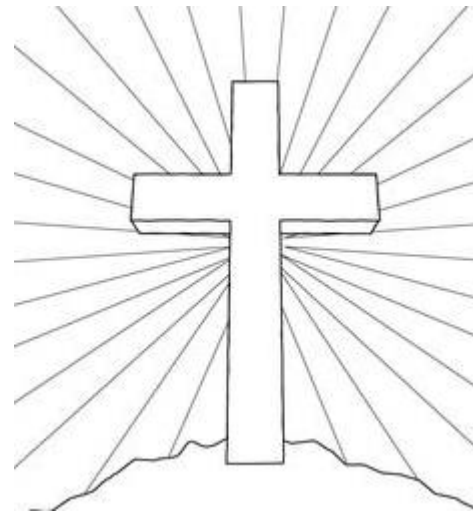
him for this Christmas and if we trust him
