comes from.

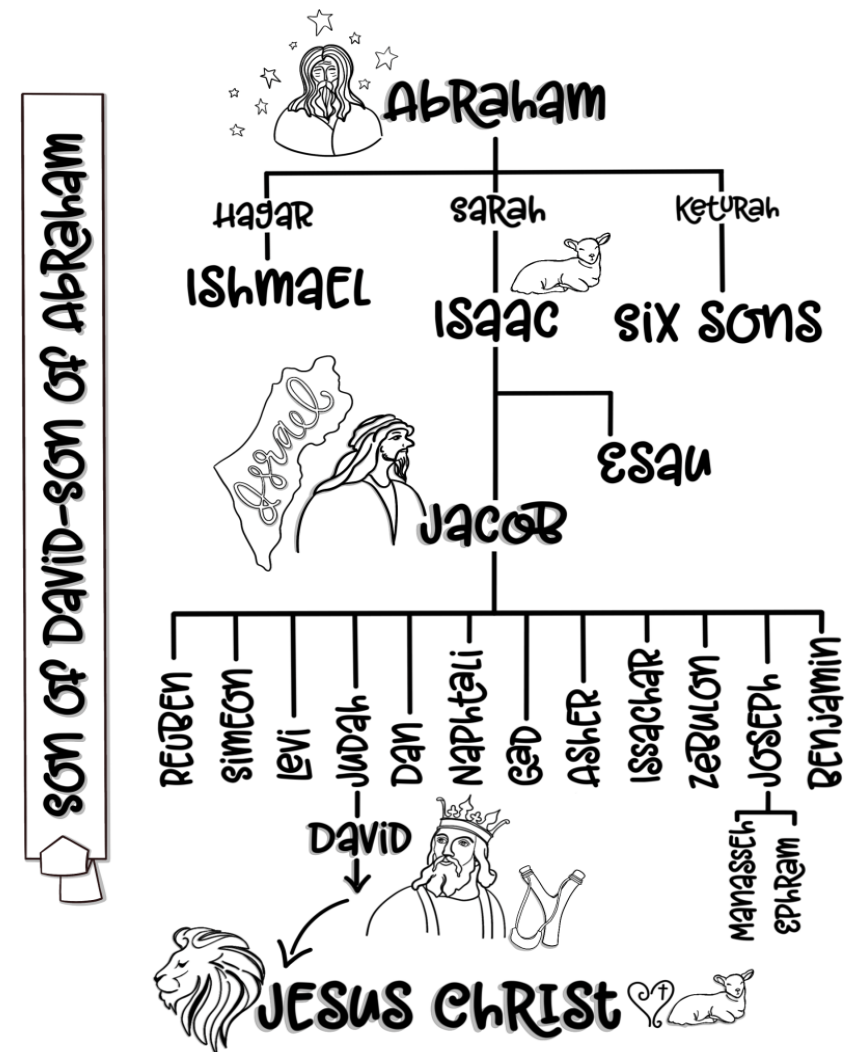
So what about us?
