He always gives us a way of escape.

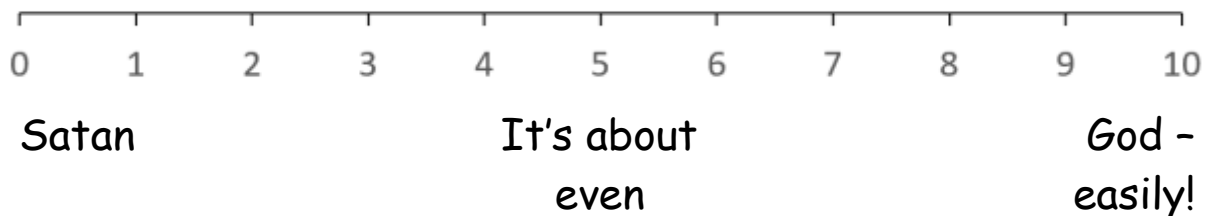
