

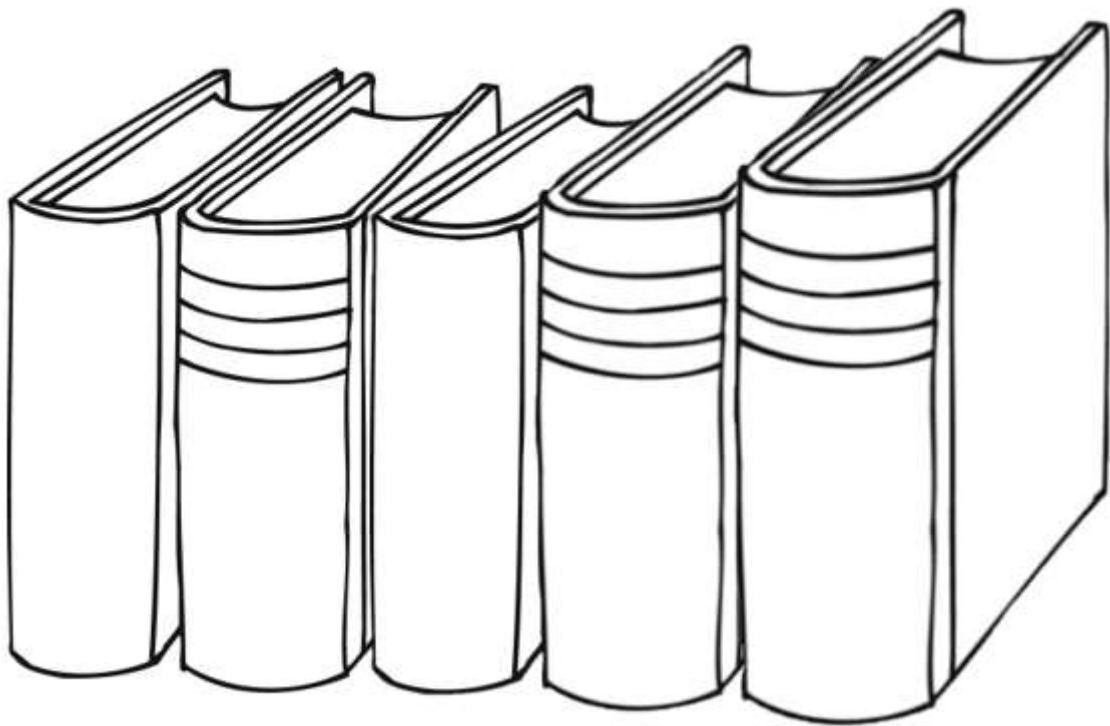
Listen carefully to the Bible reading starting from Leviticus chapter 1 verse 1.

Colour in Leviticus in the picture.



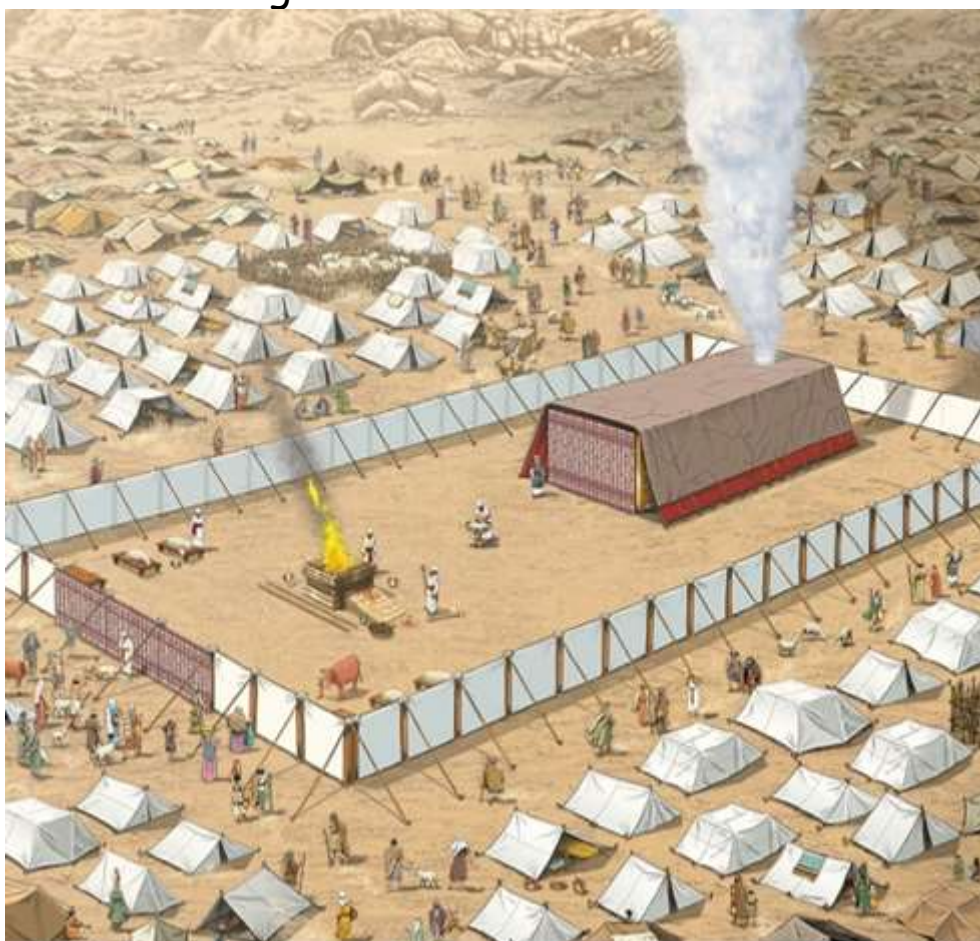
Leviticus has a special place in God's Law

The second room was the **Most Holy Place**



This is where the ark of the covenant was kept
