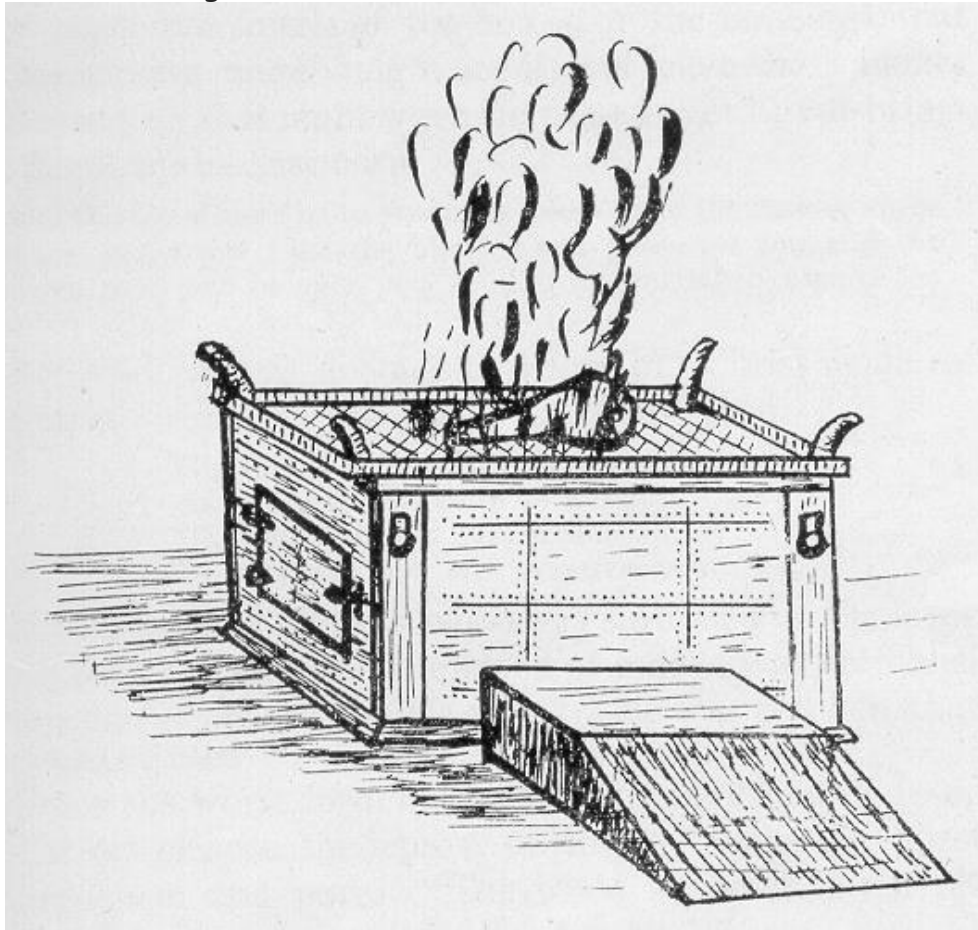

BD Children's learning sheet - Leviticus 1v1-17

Do you remember last week we started a new book of the bible,

Leviticus, and we heard

how God made a tent of meeting so that he

could meet with his people. But

how can sinful people get into that tent to meet God? Today we learn that it is

through a sacrifice. In

Leviticus we see instructions for 5 different sacrifices that God's people in the Old Testament had to

make. For us today this helps

us to see what the Lord does for us and in us and points to Jesus.

So, imagine you were

around then what would you do?

The first thing we see is that you present a

perfect sacrifice. It's

important that it is perfect, this sacrifice shows your attitude to God.

The next thing we see is that the animal is

a substitute for

you. The animal is going towards God, in your place.

Then we see that to draw near to God

there must be a death. This

has been the same ever since Adam and Eve disobeyed God in the garden of Eden and

this is why Jesus had to die.

But then, once the sacrifice has been made, you are fully

accepted by God.

This is amazing. The whole sacrifice is burnt and the smoke from the burnt sacrifice that represents us, goes up to

God and pleases Him.
