Today we're thinking about another

offering that was

brought to the Lord in the tabernacle. It might seem like a

strange offering but to

understand the offering we have to understand what had happened

before it was given. This

chapter shows us that if we've been

forgiven by the Lord

and come into his presence, then we'll want to give ourselves to Him.

This offering is called the

"Grain Offering" and it means

a 'Tribute' like something you would give to a King and it happens after you have been forgiven.

There are different ways of doing it, but

they all involve flour, an

everyday essential thing, but also something that in the tabernacle represents God's people. So, it's a picture

of bringing ourselves to God.

There is also salt involved in this

offering, to remind the people of God's covenant with them.

This offering also made God pleased. How about us today? Well, this and other passages in the New Testament help us to see that when we are forgiven people, trusting in Jesus we can also bring

ourselves to God and

this pleases him. How do we do this? By ordinary things like

sharing with others, giving

money to pay for church pastors, singing praises to God, praying. Isn't it exciting that we can do these things and they are gifts to God and please Him?
