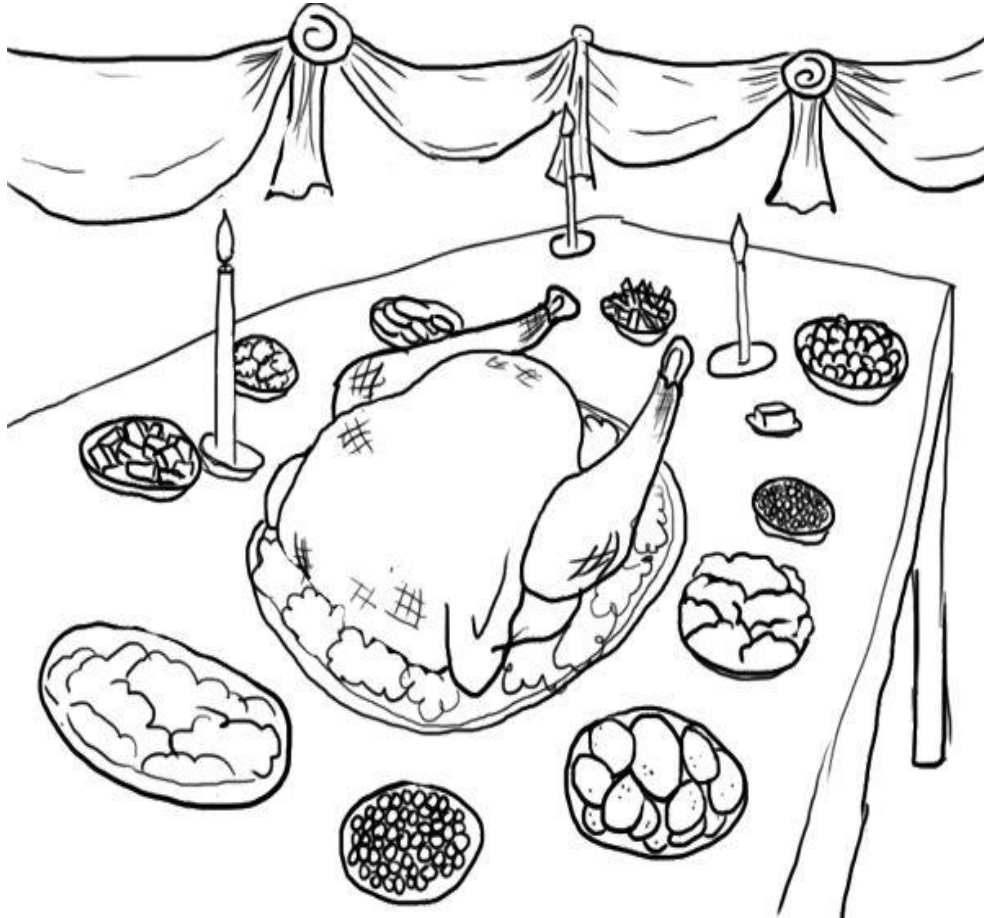

BD Children's learning sheet - Leviticus 3v1-17

Today we're thinking about another

offering, the peace

offering that was brought to the Lord in the tabernacle. This offering was all about

food.

It was about forgiven people eating a meal

with God and with

each other.

We're going to think about this offering under 3 headings:

1. What did you do?

2. What did it mean?

3. Where do Christian people now eat with God?

So firstly, what did you do?

It's almost the same as the

burnt offering that we heard about 2 weeks ago except that you only burn

part of it, the fat

and the liver and kidneys. And you burn it

on top of the

burnt offering.

Secondly what did it mean?

Firstly, we see that it is not a sacrifice

that happens on its own.

Rather, it is put on top of the burnt offering.

Secondly, when we look at other parts of the bible, we can see that in this offering the worshipper is full of

thanks to the Lord and the

Lord invites him or her to sit down and eat.

Finally, where do Christian people eat with God today?

In the Lord's Supper now

and one day in the New Creation, we have a banquet to look forward to!
