Leviticus tells us of some of the ways people might do wrong so that they need to make a Payback Offering.

First - with some of the holy things. Perhaps they ate the wrong part of one of their offerings or did something wrong in the Tabernacle.

Second - they may have broken one of God's commandments without realising it


Third - they may have lost, broken or stolen something belonging to their neighbour
