Jude writes that this should not be a surprise for a church.
We don't need to be afraid. God has warned us about it so that we can be prepared and ready to keep following Jesus!
So let's have a look at what Jude says about these troublemakers. What does he call them in verse 18?
This means people who make fun of a church and say it's ridiculous to obey and follow Jesus.

Some may do this loudly trying to turn people away

Some may do this quietly, trying to turn a church away from following Jesus, so they won't notice if they are not careful.

How do they do this? Jude tells us in verse 19
"It is these who cause"
This means to turn people against each other.
They may try to start (arugmetns)
or get people to talk about each other (nkundily)
or try to stop people following the taught (rthtu)
in the Bible.
God warns us about this to help us!
