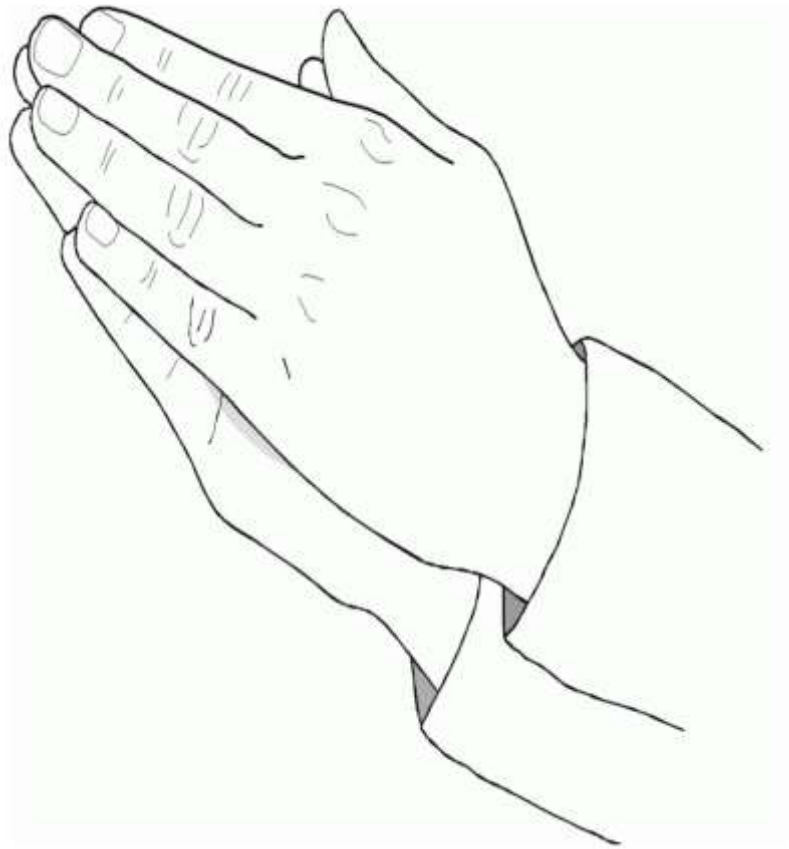


Draw a picture on the praying hands of someone or something you would like to pray for.

Today we are going to be learning about prayer.

God gives us tools like: the bible, prayer preaching, baptism, the Lord's Supper, and fellowship to achieve His purposes.

These tools are means of grace. They show us Jesus and His benefit to Christians. God promises to work through the tools He gives us.

Prayer is Hard

Praying is when we talk to God. Even children can pray!

But, sometimes it can be hard to pray if we are busy, or tired, or don't feel like it.

The book of Hebrews tells us that Jesus understands when we find prayer hard and He can help us.

Praying is Wonderful

John 1:12 tells us we are children of God. God has adopted us into His family and He loves to hear His children pray.

God's adopted children can come to the throne of grace without worrying that God will ever turn us away. We can speak to God because He is our Father.

1 Peter 5:7 tells us we can tell God our worries because He cares for us.

Praying Changes the World

Elijah was a person just like you, who prayed for rain and God heard his prayer and sent rain!

But sometimes, God doesn't give us what we want. This can make us sad but we can trust that God knows what's best for us.

The bible teaches us to pray for other people (not just ourselves) too!
