
Sin made God's house dirty. God's house was called the Tabernacle. Colour in the picture of the Tabernacle below.



Today we are in Leviticus looking at some more of the laws God gave His people.

Remember from last week, these laws taught God's people about holiness. They taught God's people how to be Clean from sin so they could come

near to Him.

But... the law was also very hard for God's people to live under.

<u>God wants to bring new life</u> God made laws about things a man's body does and things a woman's body does.

These laws were a reminder that we live in a **broken** world where our bodies don't always work properly!

This reminded God's people that we are fallen and we need God to make

us clean and whole.




Sin put God's people in danger of God leaving them!
