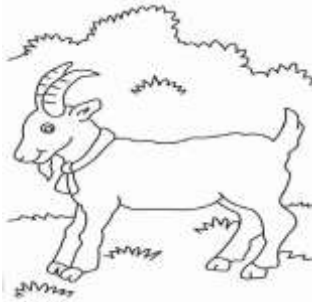


Jesus has taken our sin away from us, just like the goat was taken far away from the people on the Day of Atonement. Can you draw and colour in a goat? There is a picture of one to help you.



Today we are in Leviticus chapter 16. We are going to think about how a **holy** God can live with **sinful** people.

Chapter 16 is about the 'Day of Atonement'.

Atonement is our sins being made clean so we can live with God.

A Perfect Priest

First, the **High Priest** had to bring a sacrifice so he could be clean from sin.

For Christians, our High Priest is **Jesus**.

He sacrificed Himself to make us clean from sin.

A Clean Home

Next, the sins of the people needed to be cleaned.

Remember from last week that sin made God's house dirty. The High Priest would bring

a **goat** to sacrifice to make sure

God's house was **clean** so the people could dwell with Him.

Now, we have been made clean by Jesus. Our bodies are God's clean house as the

Holy Spirit dwells in us.

Sin Taken Away

The goat used for the sin

offering was led out of the camp, far away from the people.

Just like the goat, our sin has been taken far away from us by Jesus. We are clean from sin

forever.

God's people had to be cleansed from sin over and over again to be able to dwell with Him.

But we have Jesus as our

perfect High Priest. He has

made us clean once and for all so we can dwell with God.
