Before we listen to our Bible reading...

What does it mean to **love** someone?

When you love a person, you spend time with that person.

In today's Bible reading the Lord speaks about spending **TIME** with Him. Listen carefully! It's **Leviticus 23:1-4**.

Here's what chapter 23 and chapter 25 are all about...

The Lord fixed special times to meet with Him

He had already told them **WHERE** to meet with Him - at the "tent of meeting."

Next, he told them **WHEN** to meeting with him. So...

What was the most important time for God's people back then?

Your birthday... or summer holiday... or meeting with God

The first special time was a "sabbath" (23:3)

How often did this happen?

Once per week... or Twice... or Four times

On the Sabbath God's people were called together -
to pray and praise, to offer sacrifice, to hear the Bible.

Their special sabbath times meant that they had

The Lord still wants us to have spend special time with Him.
We can do this EVERY day. But the New Testament says
there's also a special "**Lord's Day**."

During each year there were 7 special feasts

There were special things to do. These helped God's people
remember the Lord and enjoy being together with Him.

then. But the Lord does want us to have times to
