## Leviticus chapters 23-25. Sermon outline

## Meeting with God: <u>WHEN</u>? = chapters 23 and 25 The Lord fixed special times to meet with Him

- "appointed feasts" (23:2) = God fixed a place and times (Gen. 1:14)
- weekly "sabbath" (23:3) = rest... like God... meet to worship
  - → What about us?
    Genesis 2:1-3... 4<sup>th</sup> commandment... "Lord's Day"
- 7 feasts each year (23:4-44) = to rest... remember... and worship
  - → What about us?

    Colossians 2:16-17, "don't let anyone judge you... with regard to a festival, new moon or sabbaths"
- special sabbaths throughout the years (25:1-55) = rest... freedom...
  - → What about us?
    don't build up treasures on earth

## Meeting with God: <u>WHAT?</u> = chapter 24 The Lord makes his face to shine upon his people

- The lampstand... and the bread
- **Numbers 6:23-27**, ""Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, Thus you shall bless the people of Israel: you shall say to them,

The LORD bless you and keep you;

the LORD make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you;

the LORD lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.

"So shall they put my name upon the people of Israel, and I will bless them."

- 1 John 3:2, "Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears<sup>[a]</sup> we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is."
