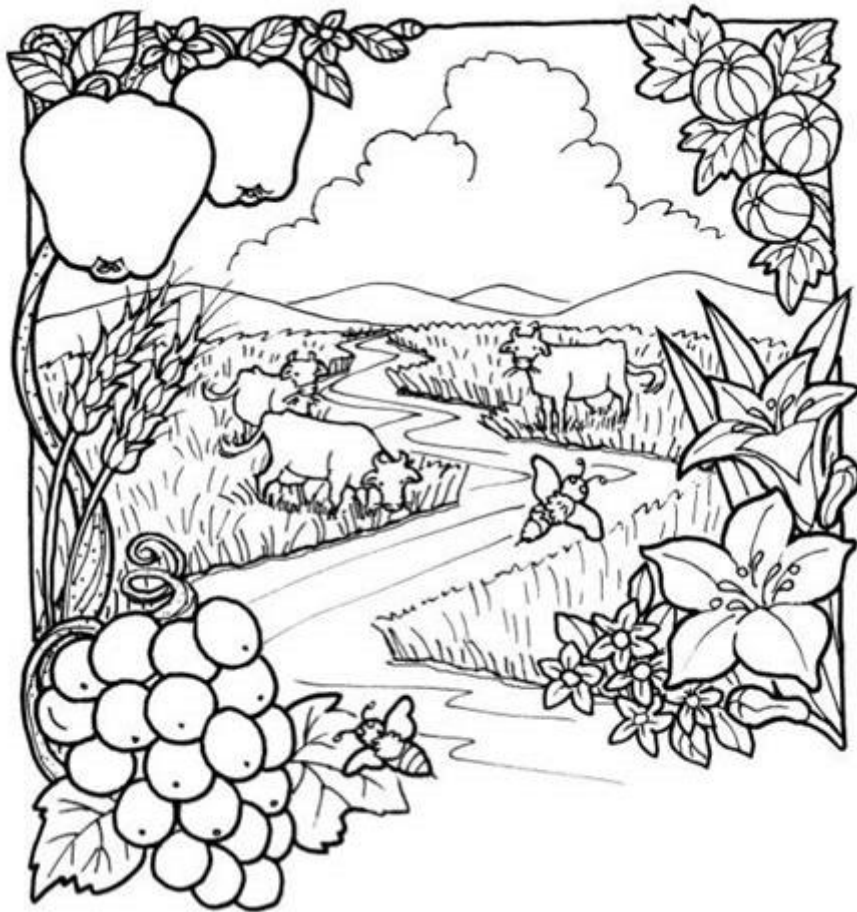


believe and trust in Jesus we get to

Warnings:

If God's people didn't obey Him, then life

would be awful. They would get

sick and wouldn't have enough food

and their enemies would attack

them.

Sadly, this is what did happen, God's people

in the Old Testament did turn their
back on God and he did punish them. But

there is also good news. God

promised in our reading that if the people
turned back to him, he would

remember his covenant
with them.

But it is even better news for us because

we are part of the New

Covenant that Jesus

brought in. Jesus took God's punishment
when he died on the cross, and if we
