The big idea today is....

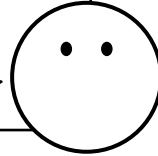


Can you draw a picture of the disciples' boat in the storm?

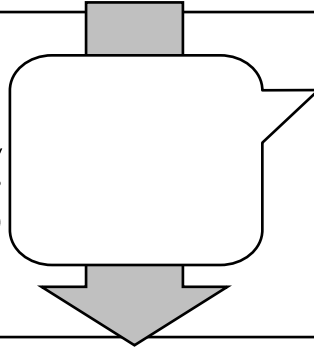
See if you can include Jesus asleep in the back of the boat!

The disciples probably looked like this →



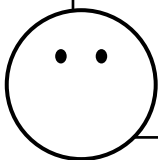
What did Jesus say
